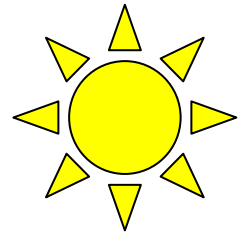

Taking Care of your Lawns

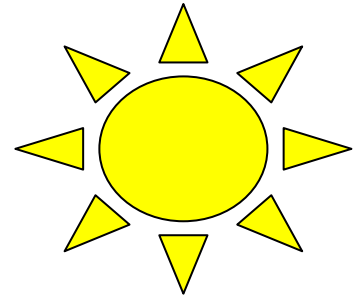
I ensure all my equipment is extremely well looked after it is regularly maintained- blades are sharpened every 10 weeks.

You may have noticed that where practical I occasionally alter the direction of the cut. This prevents the grass from continually being flattened in one direction, allows even growth, gives a more even cut and a better end result for your lawn.

What I can do for you

With growth slow at this time of year it is a great time to take a look at your garden and survey some of the more neglected areas . Overhanging branches, general pruning, overgrown weeds becoming a nuisance? I have limited slots available for garden tidy ups, pruning and weeding. Garden waste can be removed too.

Before 'n' After

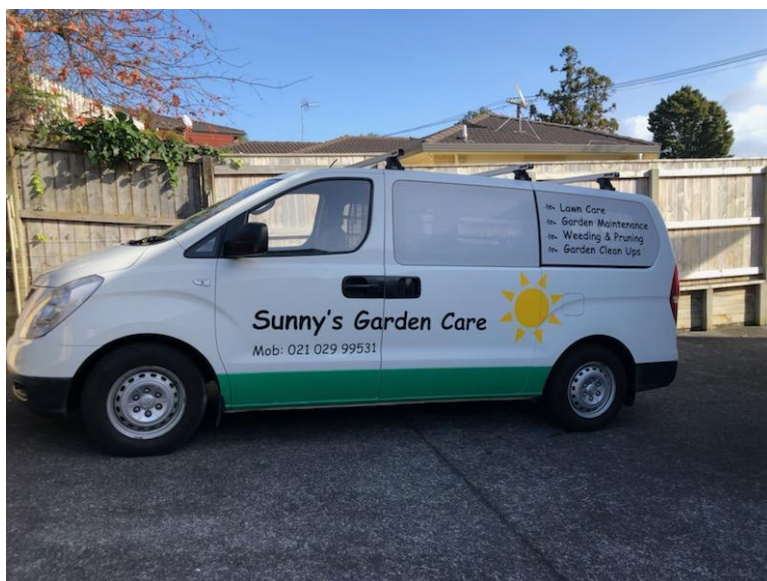


Advice Corner #1

Lawns at this time of year benefit from a good weed and feed. This will ensure good colour and growth for the coming year. You may also need to apply a moss control product however, you will need to re-seed the area once the moss has gone.

Most of the leaves have fallen now so any that remain on the lawn should be removed or mulched back into the lawn to help provide nutrients for the coming year. You can also apply a moss control product however, you will need to re-seed the area once the moss has gone.
